

Key features

1.Implementing the "Geneva Trialogue spirit"

- Academic scholars providing the basis of knowledge on SD, intercultural issues, global challenges, data mining and processing, etc.
- Strong involvement of actors coming from IGOs and global NGOs, regional/national administrations, and the private sector

2. Combining various forms of teaching

- Academic teaching
- Learning-by-doing: 4 workshops where students deal with practical issues and challenges

- Field works in Europe, Middle East, USA and China
 - •Internships




















Key features
