
GTI Dual Degree Master Program

The 2.5-year GTI Dual Degree Master Program offered by the University of Geneva and Tsinghua University trains students to analyze problems and identify innovative solutions for human development and sustainability. Its objective is to provide future changemakers with the knowledge and skills necessary to achieve social, political, technological and institutional innovation for the SDGs.





The Dual Degree combines an interdisciplinary M.Sc. in Innovation, Human Development and Sustainability (IHDS) in Geneva and an MPA entitled Master of Public Policy SDGs (MPP-SDG) in Beijing. It includes a high proportion of handson learning activities alongside fundamental courses on sustainable development in all its dimensions: social, economic and environmental. In Geneva, students work on projects mentored by experts from International Organisations (IOs). At Tsinghua, a field trip to Shenzhen, China's Silicon Valley, is a highlight. Students can start the program in Beijing or Geneva. A one-semester internship with an IO or other organization is mandatory in Geneva, and a one-semester thesis is mandatory in Beijing.



The University of Geneva also offers a Single Degree, 2-year track that includes an exchange semester at a number of partner universities around the world.
