About ReModelUN Workshop

ReModelUN Workshop (previously Geneva Triologue) is a one-day event held in Geneva with and for the Model United Nations (MUN), an international network of over 1M high school and university students who organize UN-style negotiations every year. This is a youth community that is passionate about achieving peace through multilateral dialogue and progress through international cooperation.

As in previous years' successful edition, the focus is on leveraging responsible artificial intelligence to improve the experience and outcomes of MUN conferences and to assist UN partner agencies seeking youth feedback, with the ambitious goal of enabling youth to inspire UN negotiations.

ReModelUN Workshop is not an MUN conference, it is a place for three stakeholders to discuss and develop the future of MUN: youth who are active in MUNs; representatives of International Organisations and their Member States; AI experts from Academia and the Private Sector. Hence the concept of a Triologue.

ReModelUN Workshop is organized during the International Telecommunications Union (ITU) World Summit on the Information Society **WSIS Forum 2026**, which takes place 7-11 July, during the same week as ITU's flagship event on Artificial Intelligence, the **AI for Good Summit**. Organizers are University of Geneva's SDG Solution Space, Learning Planet Institute and mymun. Sponsors are AICrowd and Dorahacks.
